Industry can give it to them by adopting best practices in Collaborative Working and Contracting – proven methods that are available but not applied universally as an industry standard. **Thankfully, an industry standard has been created by the UK's ECITB in the form of the Project Collaboration Toolkit.** It has been recently applied on capital offshore projects achieving up to 40% cost savings. Now in its second edition, and closely aligned with ISO 44001 on collaborative business relationships, the Toolkit has been updated to fit all industry sectors engaged in capital projects.

In our first event Collaborative Contracting Community of Practice members will facilitate a discussion about how our industry can benefit by making Collaborative Working and Contracting more main stream. Specifically, we will address:

- Shifting the individual and cultural mindset to establish a collaborative environment;
